## Wangaratta Fat Cattle Market Report

A lighter yarding of 185 head came forward at the Wangaratta Livestock Exchange. This was 35 less than last week and comprised of 145 young cattle, 39 cows and 1 bull.

Quality was not as good as last week with fewer grown steers penned, a reasonable offering of heifers-mainly lighter weights and a sprinkling of vealers.

Demand was limited for most classes with grown steers easing by 5 cents, heifers 5 to 8 cents below last week and vealers were 6 to 8 cents easier. The 39 cows sold at firm rates.
